Message from Principal Steve Kidd

To say that last school year ended a little differently than was expected would be an understatement. Gibault graduated a group of seniors that took all the hits COVID-19 had to offer and endured. They lost prom, spring sports, bacalaureate, and so many other honored traditions that accompany the final year of high school. They even experienced an outdoor July graduation and an online Awards Night program. Through it all, they complained little and gained a lot. The Gibault Class of 2020 is stronger because of how they accepted reality, adapted to the changes, and eventually moved on toward their futures without hesitation.

It is now the start of a new year at Gibault Catholic High School, and we have come back together with a renewed confidence. We have been in session this fall since day one, and our students, staff, and parents have made a commitment to being in school and doing it safely. Our students have shown a great desire to be at school and a mature approach that will allow them the greatest chance to remain. Wearing masks and social distancing are a temporary, but necessary, daily practice. We are addressing the constant changes COVID-19 creates while trying to make our school year as normal as possible. Someday these will be great stories to tell their grandchildren, about how they attended high school during a global pandemic. It is their equivalent to walking to school every day, uphill both ways.

As with most years, we rely on the generosity of our alumni and supporters to help us through. This pandemic has added difficult financial strains. Our already thin budget has been stretched even further as the Federal Cares Act that promised to help all students in our nation was stripped down to almost nothing. We expected to receive about \$8,000 through this grant, but in the end, only received about \$1,000 to make Gibault safe. It was disappointing, but we refused cut corners when it came to our students. Because of decreased abilities to fundraise with events, the Annual Fund has become increasingly important to help fill some of these gaps. We humbly are asking for your strong support for this 20/21 school year. It is important we can continue to make Gibault available to all who want to be a Hawk.

Our mission to this community is clear - to provide a quality education, rooted in Jesus Christ, for all who desire to be here. We will continue to do this through all the obstacles this new decade throws at us.
