
# Why should I give to the Annual Fund?

You need an account on mytax.illinois.gov before applying for a tax credit. This can take up to 10 days and involves a mailed pin.

#### 2. Reserve

After you register, you can reserve your tax credit for the 2019 calendar year with the Illinois DOR in order to make a donation.

#### 3. Donate

Once you receive confirmation of your tax credit, you have 60 days to make your donation\* to Empower Illinois. \*no minimum

This scholarship requires the family to be within 185-300% of the Federal Poverty Level, and for 2019-20 Gibault students that applied qualified for \$312,000.

Last year we were designated less than 10% of that amount.


