HAVE YOU HEARD ABOUT OUR FAMILY SPORTS PASS? For \$125 you get into every home sporting event at Gibault! Yes, that does include Boys' Soccer at Oerter Park this year! Just flash your pass and head in! This pass is perfect for multi-sport families or for the sports fan that loves to come out to watch all Gibault sporting events! If you are interested in purchasing one, you can purchase these passes at all home games (a QR code will be available) and in the front office at Gibault. One pass covers immediate family only (parents and children living in the same household.) So, for \$125 you can see boys' soccer games, girls' volleyball games, girls' basketball games including the Candy Cane Classic, boys' basketball games, and girls' soccer games! For all other sports including tennis, boys and girls golf, cross-country, bowling, softball, baseball, and track, the admittance will be free! Unfortunately, this pass does not include any IHSA postseason games at Gibault.




