Dr. Geoffrey Miller named Principal of Gibault Catholic High School



The Most Reverend Michael McGovern, Bishop of Belleville, has named Geoffrey Miller, Ph.D., Principal of Gibault Catholic High School in Waterloo. His appointment is effective January 1, 2025.

Dr. Miller has twenty years of experience in Catholic education and seven years of experience in administration. He was co-principal at St. Ignatius College Prep in Chicago, an adjunct instructor for Seminars in Ignatian Leadership, a Provincial Assistant at the Society of Jesus in St. Louis, an Associate Professor of Theology at St. Louis University, and a Theology teacher at Rockhurst High School in Kansas City, Missouri, Regis High School in New York, and Gonzaga College High School in Washington, DC. Dr. Miller is proficient in six languages, has created multiple Catholic websites and online courses, and has received numerous honors and awards, including the Helen I. Mandeville Award for Excellence in Teaching in the Humanities.

Dr. Miller received his Bachelor of Arts in Philosophy and Religious Studies at Indiana University, his Master of Arts in Historical Theology at St. Louis University and his Ph. D. in Theology and Religious Studies at The Catholic University of America.

"I am very pleased to welcome Dr. Geoff Miller to Gibault Catholic High School," said Bishop McGovern. "Given his Catholic faith and background, I have every confidence that he will excel as principal for Gibault. I think he will collaborate well with the staff and parents and be a great educational leader for the students."

As we transition into additional new leadership at Gibault Catholic High School with Dr. Miller, it is a good time to review our roots and as Sr. Joan Chittister said, "Why we do what we do is more important than what we do?" Gibault is the legacy of the vision of Fr. Ed Hustedde. He founded a school like no other, based on the Gospels, on trust, on self-determination and on allowing students to seek more than a traditional classroom experience. Catholic identity, social justice, a preferential option for the poor, the humanities, a love of God's creation, the modular schedule, the Gibault Senior Project, attention to the arts, academic excellence,

St. Louis University credits, and opportunities in athletics, academic and extracurricular competitions were his implementation that has been carried on by the Gibault Faculty and Staff since 1966. HALL OF FAME Gibault is very excited and proud to announce our Athletic Hall of Fame for 2025. On January 11 between the JV and Varsity game we will be bringing

into the Hall of Fame the 2000 State Champions Bowling Team who includes Coach Larry Schaltenbrand, Matt Kaestner, Aaron Woodside, Tim Mitchell, Chris Monterusso, and Eric Frey. All five bowlers are from the Class of 2000.

This year is the 25th anniversary of their win. They are the first state champions of Gibault!

We will also be bringing in Hannah Wessel Sasser (Class of 2012.) Some of Hannah's highlights include 12 varsity letters (4 volleyball, 4 soccer, 3 cheer, 1 basketball), Soccer MVP, Vernie Moffit Award, and the St. Louis Post Dispatch Scholar Athlete. During Hannah's time on the volleyball team, she was a 4-year varsity letter winner and a 3-year varsity captain. Her senior year she led the Hawks with 281 kills (605 career kills) and ranked among area leaders as she helped Gibault to a fourth-place finish at the Illinois Class 1A state tournament. She garnered IHSA honorable mention All-State honors to go with first team All-Area accolades. Hannah went onto play volleyball for 4 years at McKendree College. While at McKendree College, she earned Academic All-GLVC honors twice and had over 600 kills including being second on the team her sophomore year with 234 kills.
