School dress code exists to uphold each student's dignity and build school culture.

Penalty for violating dress code includes detention and correction of the problem.

Please note: the example images below are not comprehensive of all acceptable/unacceptable options.



Uniform Dress Code



Gibault Uniform

- GCHS embroidered polo shirts must be worn at all times.
- Gibault branded outerwear is optional.
- Shirts must be tucked in.
- Skirts must be at least fingertip length.
- Shorts must have an 8-inch inseam.
- Shorts and pants must be solid-colored with belt loops. No distressing. No cargo pockets. No drawstrings.
- Shorts and pants must be worn with a belt.
- Shoes must be closed-toe and closed-back and worn with socks.



Unacceptable Uniform Shorts or Pants

Students may wear solid-colored pants with belt loops that fit appropriately. Denim pants, skinny fit pants, form fitting pants, overly baggy pants, cargo pants, or frayed fabric pants are not acceptable. Solid-colored shorts with belt loops may be worn year-round in lieu of pants. Shorts must have a minimum 8-inch inseam. Accent stripes, rivets, decorations, cargo pockets, or frays are not acceptable.

Unacceptable Shirts

Cropped tops and tank tops are not acceptable. Midriffs must not be visible. Shirts with profanity/drugs/alcohol are not acceptable, including bar or beer logos. Cutoff sleeves are not acceptable.



Unacceptable Shorts

Shorts must have a minimum of a 5-inch inseam and be appropriate for school. Inappropriate shorts would include spandex shorts, overly thin material, see-through material, and glute lifting/cinched styles.



✓ Approved Shorts

Unacceptable Jeans

Jeans with holes are not acceptable. Lightly distressed jeans are permitted.

Unacceptable Shoes

Shoes must be closed toe and closed back. Socks must be worn with shoes. Sandals, flip flops, crocs, slippers, etc. are not acceptable.

Leggings must be dark-colored and appropriate for school. Inappropriate leggings would include overly thin material, see-through material, and glute lifting/cinched styles.

Unacceptable Skirts

Skirts and dresses must be at least fingertip length.

Young ladies may wear short or long dresses, but dresses should be modest and appropriate in length (fingertip rule). Thin straps and strapless are acceptable. Cutouts, plunging necklines, and fully bare backs are not acceptable.

Young men should wear slacks and button-down shirts; tie and jacket optional. No jeans or casual wear.



Hair, Jewelry, and Tattoos



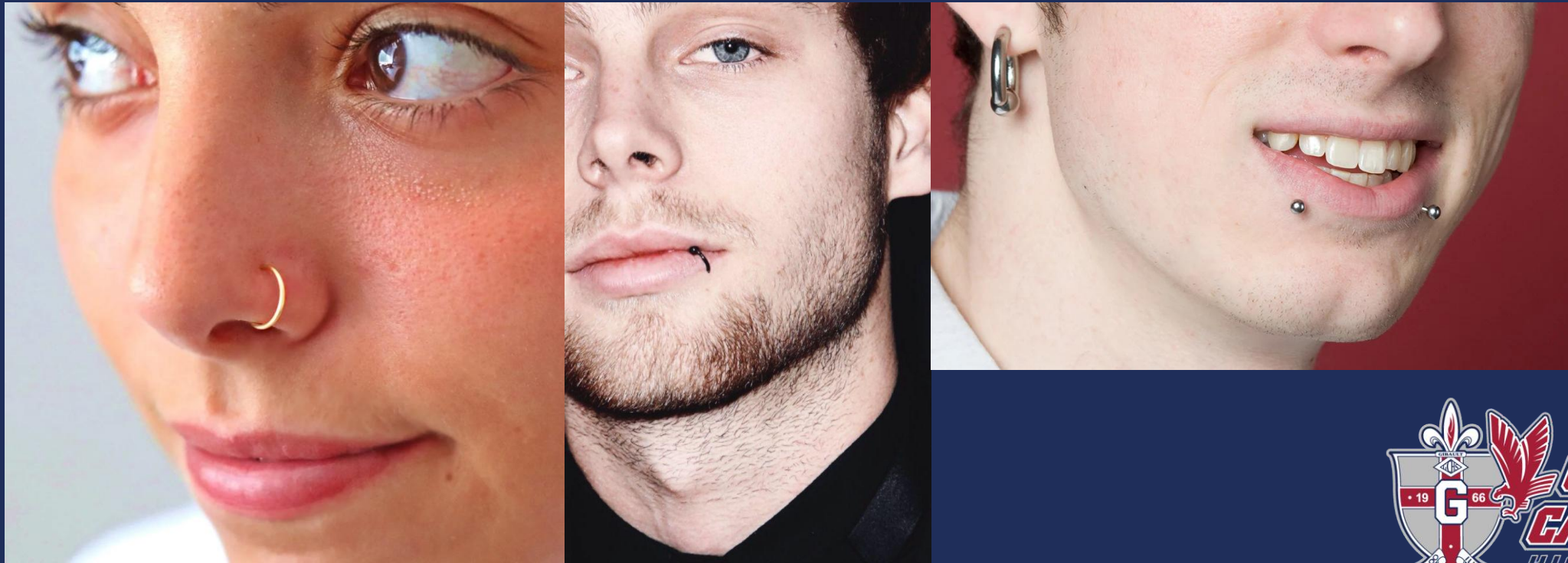
Unacceptable Hairstyles

Facial jewelry and visible body piercings except for earrings are prohibited.



Unacceptable Tattoos

Tattoos, permanent or temporary, should not be visible.
